- ❖ **Appearance:** What does he/she look like?



I. The Solar System

- There are **eight** planets in the solar system: **Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune.**


- The Solar System also has moons, asteroids, comets, minor planets, dust and gas.

II. The Sun

- The Sun is actually a **star**.

- The Sun is the center of solar system.

- It takes Earth **365 $\frac{1}{4}$** days (one year) to complete the orbit of the Sun.



- The Sun has a strong gravitational pull so it can hold the planets in position.

III. Solid planets and Gaseous planets

Solid planets	Gaseous planets
Planets are made from rock .	Planets are made from gas .
Mercury	Jupiter
Venus	Saturn
Earth	Uranus
Mars	Neptune

Length is used to measure the distance between two points.

It also measures how long an object is, its height, and its width.

Units of measurement

metre (m), centimeter (cm), millimeter (mm)

$1\text{ m} = 100\text{ cm}$; $1\text{ cm} = 10\text{ mm}$

Language of measurement

taller, tallest, shorter, shortest, longer, longest, equal to
